"For those of us who like to immerse ourselves in sense-assaulting love stories, this 1957 Leo McCarey classic is as good as it gets", writes **The Guardian**. "A relentlessly heart-tugging tale of two soulmates whose love even great tragedy cannot tear asunder, An Affair to Remember tosses and turns the emotions but never descends into schmaltz; it stays compelling – partly down to its smart, surprisingly sassy script, which often holds back when it could go for the cheap weep, but also because it is brought to us by two of the classiest acts in Hollywood history: Cary Grant and Deborah Kerr."

You've likely heard George Gershwin's Rhapsody in Blue. But did you know there's a Rhapsody No. 2? Gershwin also wrote musicals, composed an opera, created music for Hollywood film scores, and regularly played tennis with Arnold Schoenberg! Dr. Leonard explores one of America's best-known composers. Expect to hear some favorites and discover some new treasures.

<u>WINDROWS WARBLERS CHORUS CONCERT</u>: Friday, April 25th from 4:00pm-5:00pm in the Gallery. "SONDHEIM! A Stephen Sondheim Review"

With his keen wit, sharp wordplay, and distinctive musical style, Stephen Sondheim revitalized Broadway in the 1960s and '70s, proving that rumors of its death were greatly exaggerated. Even before these contributions, he made his mark by providing the lyrics for two of the most important works in the genre, West Side Story (1957) and Gypsy (1959). Hit shows from this time include A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum (1962), Company (1970), Follies (1971), A Little Night Music (1973), Sweeney Todd: The Demon Barber of Fleet Street (1979). He went on to contribute lasting works of art in his shows Merrily We Roll Along (1981), Sunday in the Park with George (1984), and Into the Woods (1987). The Warblers will perform a selection of songs from these shows.

SUNDAY MUSCIALE OPERA: Sunday, April 27, at 6:00 PM in the Marks Gallery. The April opera feature will be Giuseppe Verdi's "Il Trovatore" (The Troubadour). The premier of this opera was in 1853. This recording features Joan Sutherland as Leonora. A soldier tells the story of the Count di Luna's father burning a gypsy woman as a witch. Her daughter kidnaps the Count's younger brother. It is assumed that the sister has burned the Count's brother as revenge. Leonora, a lady-in-waiting to the Queen, has been serenaded by a mysterious troubadour. Leonora has fallen in love with him. But the Count di Luna loves Leonora. The scene changes to the gypsy camp, where the gypsies are working and singing the Anvil Chorus. Space restrictions do not allow further description of the plot other than to say, as is typical in opera tragedies of this period, the good characters die, and the evil characters live on. But you get to listen to Joan Sutherland.
