SUNDAY MUSICALE OPERA: Sunday, May 4th at 3:00pm in the Marks Gallery. The opera for May is "Count Ory" by Gioachino Rossini.

In 1824, Rossini was summoned to Paris to breathe new life into its opera culture. One of his best innovations in this period was the creation of an entirely new genre of opera comedy. "Count Ory" was the initial presentation that displayed what he created. The plot is light,

just a tissue, but the music was an instant success. The overture is at times played at concerts by symphony orchestra concerts. The plot, such as it is, revolves around a countess whose husband is away fighting in some sort of crusade and the attempt by Count Ory, a womanizer, to seduce her. One goes to hear the music and how Rossini cleverly fits the plot and music together.

Robert Hutchings served as Chairman of the NIC from 2003 to 2005 and co-edited the only history of this remarkable organization: *Truth to Power: A History of the U.S. National Intelligence Council* (Oxford University Press, 2019). In this talk, he will tell the inside story of the NIC from its origins in the wartime OSS and all the way up to such recent challenges as the Russian invasion of Ukraine.
